



Student Dress Code

Any student not in conformity with personal appearance and dress code guidelines may be subject to disciplinary consequences.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

1. No tongue rings, nose earrings, eyebrow earrings, gauges or plugs at any time.
2. No excessive jewelry, (School is not responsible for any lost or stolen jewelry).
3. No ripped jean pants.
4. No crocs.
5. No open toe sandal, flip flops and heels.

SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Students are expected to arrive to school properly dressed and groomed. DRESS CODE FOR SPECIAL SCHOOL ACTIVITIES
